



1. Smart & inclusive growth (€491bn)




- 2. Sustainable growth, natural resources (€383bn)

What is Horizon 2020

- Commission proposal for a 80 billion euro research and innovation funding programme (2014-2020)
- A core part of Europe 2020, Innovation Union & European Research Area:
 - Responding to the economic crisis to invest in future jobs and growth
 - Addressing people's concerns about their livelihoods, safety and environment
 - Strengthening the EU's global position in research, innovation and technology





Three priorities:

- 1. Excellent science
- 2. Industrial leadership
- 3. Societal challenges
